




## Minnesota's population at-a-glance

- Minnesota's 2019
   population was estimated to be 5,639,632
- Minnesota's population grew 6% between 2010 and 2019, adding 335,705 residents.

#### Percent change in population 2010-2019




## Population change in other states...for scale 2010-2019



#### 2010-2019

- 80% of the state's growth occurred in the Twin Cities 7county metro.
- Hennepin and Ramsey added
   153,00 jointly, 46% of the state's growth.


## Population trends do not always equal enrollment trends

#### Change in older adults, age 65+ (in thousands)





# For the first time in MN history: More 65+ than school-age by 2020








#### High school students graduating on time by racial and ethnic group





### Growth in Minnesota is attributable to populations of color






# Median Household Income by Race (2019 dollars) Minnesota, 2006-2019



# Household Pulse Survey: Changes in schooling due to COVID-19







#### Foreign born in Minnesota



# The state's BIPOC communities are jointly growing at ~ .5 of a percentage point per year


#### Percentage Populations of Color




At .5 percentage points per year:

- 21.5% in 2020
- 26.5% in 2030
- 31.5% in 2040
- 36.5% in 2050
